

Overview

A 3-day InfoBatch training course providing information on advanced configuration topics. This course alternates between classroom instruction and hands-on configuration exercises led by experienced software engineers.

Students are guided through various examples and exercises that review Advanced Items, Best Practices and higher-level configuration tasks such as AutoGen triggers.

Training Prerequisites

Students should have a basic knowledge of the following technologies: SQL, XML, HTML, CSS, XSLT & XPath. Trainees will access Informetric's training environment via Remote Desktop. Students are required to bring a laptop computer with Remote Desktop Connection enabled.
